Application for a foreshore licence

- > Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 19 of the Foreshore Act, 1933 that Irish Water, Colvill House, 24-26 Talbot Street, Dublin 1 has applied to the Minister of the Environment, Community and Local Government for a licence under Section 3 of the said Act to undertake Site Investigation works for the Greater Dublin Drainage scheme.

Wexford or foreshore@environ.ie
The closing date for submissions is close of business on 20th January 2015.
